3 year old Extended 15 hours (aka 30 funded hours)

The guidance below relates to anyone looking to benefit from the Extended 15 Hours from September. It does not apply to the Universal 15 hours (current scheme) or other funded childcare (FEET).

The HMRC has now opened their website so you can check eligibility for the Extended 15 hours. A code from the HMRC is required before you can pre book sessions including the additional hours. HMRC Childcare Site ( <https://www.gov.uk/childcare-calculator> ).

**IMPORTANT**

\* If you request a code prior to 1st June YOU WILL NEED to do this again BEFORE the 31st August for eligibility in September as codes are only valid for 3 months.

\* Local Authority guidance states codes MUST be obtained BEFORE the "term" start date that you wish to claim the Extended Hours. i.e. for September codes must be obtained by 31st August 2017

What do you need to do when you have your code?

We have launched a specific "Session Request Extended Hours" ( <http://cherrychildcare.co.uk/parents-guides/30-hours-qfundedq-childcare.html> ) form for those Parents wishing to increase sessions (to take advantage of the 15 extended hours) OR to allocate extended hours to existing sessions from September. Extended hours is not an automatic entitlement.

Once you have completed and signed the form hand it into the nursery office who will be able to give you an indicative cost (if required) and confirm the availability for the sessions you are requesting. Due to demand and availability we may be unable to satisfy all requests so, please get your requests in early to avoid disappointment!

Please read the terms and conditions carefully.
